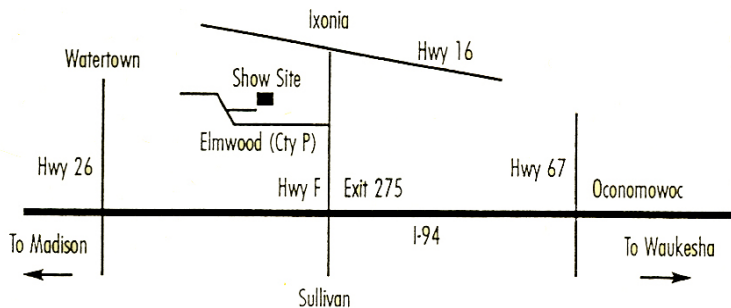

WISCONSIN ANIMAL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

In order to comply With the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [so 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [so ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination.

Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog.

Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used.

JUDGING PROGRAM

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule printed in this program.

The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The show giving club and superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Being an unbenched show, exhibitors need to be at the show only in time for their judging and may leave any time after judging.
